## Why did God have to take on flesh?

# To become a merciful and faithful High Priest.

and that he might make atonement for the sins of the people. Hebrews 2:17 NIV

### To make atonement for sin.

Because he himself suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted. Hebrews 2:18 NIV

## To relate to our struggles so he could help.

Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. Hebrews 4:14 NIV

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. Hebrews 4:15 NIV

Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need. Hebrews 4:16 NIV
